## Day 1, 26 June

#### Technical hands-on training on Autodesk Fusion

No previous experience required.

Participants will need to create an Autodesk Student Plan account, then install and activate Autodesk Fusion for free on the Autodesk Education Community: https://www.autodesk.com/education/students

The following areas will be covered in the training session:

Topic area	Description
Data Panel	Creating a new project and inviting peers. Workflow for collaboration such as saving files and other important tips.
Fusion 360 UI	Parametric modelling, Direct modelling, Browser, Timeline and other interface components.
2D Sketch Workspace	Detailed explanation of all commands under the Create, Modify, Constraints panels.
3D Modeling Workspace	Explanation of important commands under the Create, Modify, Construct and Insert panels.
T-Splines / Freeform Modeling Workspace	Explanation of commands under the Create, Modify, Symmetry and Utilities panels and example creation.
Render Workspace	Appearance, Scene Settings, Texture Map Control, In canvas and cloud rendering options, HDRI usage.
Delivering the project	Key considerations when sharing and submitting your project.
Next Steps	Use of the Autodesk forums, demonstration of how to share on the Autodesk Community Gallery, etc.

#### Designathon competition

You will compete with your team against other students by solving a design challenge, which can play a part in the transition towards a more sustainable future. Showcase your creativity and design skills in crafting concepts for a better world.

The competition topic will be revealed in the morning on day 2 and you will have time to research and model different solutions using the skills acquired on day 1.

Submitted design solutions will be evaluated by an expert jury based on the following criteria:
