

Autodesk Designathon 2025

Competition terms and conditions

Eligibility

- You must be a student at a technical college, university or an Autodesk Authorized Academic Partner.
- You must enter as a team – the minimum team size is 2 people; the maximum is 3 people.
- Each team member needs to submit a unique email address when registering to ensure that we can provide all participants with relevant information and updates.

Submission guidelines

- The competition design brief will be announced on 28 June 2025. All competition entries must adhere to these conditions.
- All projects must be designed using the Autodesk Fusion platform.
- Participants must upload their final designs through the official competition submission form.

- Submissions must include a description of the project and a link to the 3D-model in Autodesk Fusion.
- All entries must be submitted by 19:00 BST on 28 June 2025. Late submissions will not be considered by the jury.

Originality and intellectual property

- Submitted projects must be the original work of the participants.
- Any form of plagiarism or infringement of intellectual property rights will result in disqualification.
- By entering, participants grant KnowledgePoint and Autodesk a non-exclusive license to use, reproduce, and display their projects and designs for promotional purposes.

Judging criteria

- Designs will be evaluated based on three criteria categories. See the judging criteria document for a detailed overview.

- Decisions by the appointed jury are final and cannot be appealed.

Awards and recognition

- The top 3 teams will receive cash prizes, or gift certificates in the equivalent value.
- All registered participants will receive an Autodesk Certificate of Participation, which will be sent to the email address entered on the registration form.
- The organizers may opt to award additional recognition for noteworthy submissions. The winners of these awards will need to confirm acceptance within a set time period.
- The winners are expected to be announced on 22 July 2025.

Participation and conduct

- Participants are expected to conduct themselves professionally and respectfully.

- Any form of cheating, disruption, or unreasonable behaviour will result in disqualification.
- KnowledgePoint reserves the right to modify the terms and conditions or cancel the competition at any stage.

Privacy and data protection:

- Personal information collected during registration will be used for the administration of the competition.
- Registered participants agree that KnowledgePoint and our partners may contact them with information related to the competition prior to, during, and after it.
